Post-operative Instructions: Forearm Fracture

- Start finger ROM immediately after surgery. Elevate as much as possible. No lifting/pushing/pulling with hand.
- Follow up with me 7-10 days after surgery. OT for removable functional forearm brace. OK to come out of splint for hygiene and daily ROM exercises.
 Start gentle active ROM. Lift < 2lbs.
- 2-6 weeks: Continue hand therapy with active wrist and elbow ROM exercises. Continue ROM until normal. Scar desensitization. Lift < 5 lbs.
- 6-12 weeks: Wean out of splint. Begin strengthening and passive ROM, lift <
 10 lbs or 3 lbs if repetitive motion.
- Start work conditioning or return to sport program at 8 weeks.
- OK to return to full duty manual labor or contact sports at 3 months.
